

Mouflon Ram hunting in Hungary & Czech Republic 2021-2022 Price list based offer

Highlights

We offer this hunt for those who don't mind working hard for a trophy animal, and a full curl ram is still missing from the wall. Mouflon hunt in Central-Europe is one of the most affordable sheep hunting options. This representative of the sheep family was introduced in 1870s into hilly areas in Hungary, where they have found their optimal habitat. Previously, the overgrown population was causing problems in certain areas due to their eating habits, while being hurt by the growing wolf population in others. The habitat and the mouflon's high alertness make this hunt challenging – and success highly rewarding for mountain enthusiasts. While the best time for mouflon hunting is between November and January, we have year-round options in certain free range areas under special permits or private estates.



Hunting:

The mouflon is typically active during the daytime, so we can hunt for them anytime during the day. As all members of the sheep family, mouflon have a heightened sense of hearing and seeing, and few animals in the flock are in full alert all the time.

To be successful in mouflon hunting requires good physical shape, patience, solid stalking and shooting skills.





During the mating season, loud, banging noises can be heard for kilometers as the rams are fighting. The rutting season runs November until mid-December, but mouflon ram can be successfully hunted all year round. Big, old rams live solitudely most of the year, joining the flock for the mating season only. Their favorite habitat is the rocky hilltops, we can find them feeding on grassy upland meadows, even small agriculture parcels. Over the winter they show up on feeding stations where we support game animals to survive the cold season.

Stalking is the most enjoyable way to hunt mouflon, sometimes we use high-seat around the most frequented areas.

Hunting Season:

01 October-28 February

All year round with special permits or private estates.

Hunting area:

Although Mouflon is found in most countries in Europe, the Central- European stocks are the strongest and biggest in trophy size in the region. The most significant genetic population can be found in Czech Republic and very solid flocks live in Hungary and Slovakia as well. We hunt for Mouflon in both countries, looking for big rams in their hilly or mountainous rocky habitat between 2.000 and 4.000 feet above sea level.

Our well-managed, 400-1.200 hectares (800-2.500 acres) high fenced hunting grounds provide the best chances for big rams with same experience and challenge as free range hunting.

Hunting Upgrades and Combinations:

Mouflon hunt can be combined with Red Stag, Fallow Buck, Wild Boar, Small Game, or any other European species based on logistics and hunting season overlaps.

Trophy Size:

Hungarian and Slovakian mouflon population are sustainably solid, producing rams up to 85-95 cm (33-37 inches) length horns in free range, and we have access to hunting grounds in Czech, where 100 cm (38 inches) trophy can be realistic.





Accommodation:

Our 3 star hunting lodges at the hunting areas provide quality accommodations, relaxing environment, genuine hospitality, abundant home-made food and attentive service.

On request, we can arrange high-end accommodation in reachable distance, such castles, chateaus, Spa or Wine hotels if possible.



Pricing:

The total hunting costs divide into daily Service fees and Trophy fee.

Service package: (5 night / 4 hunting day)

- airport transfer
- 5 night lodging and full board meal
- 4 hunting days, 1/1 guiding
- 4x4 usage during the hunt
- hunting license and insurance
- trophy cleaning and scoring



Extras (not included in the package):

- gun rental: € 150/ day + ammo
- non hunter daily rate: € 200/ day
- official trophy scoring: € 30/ each (by CIC system)

International medal scoring:

185 CIC points – Bronze (68-73 cm / 27-29 inches)

The comparison between CIC points and length is indicative only. The basis round measurement of the horn also effects the scoring.
